Land Titles Ordinance

After briefings and exchange of views with members of the Land Titles Ordinance Steering Committee (LTOSC) on the revised proposal of the "Two-Stage Conversion Mechanism", the Land Registry is further revising the proposal and the rectification and indemnity arrangements to address some new issues and concerns raised by stakeholders. Subject to responses from stakeholders, a public consultation on the proposed amendments to the Land Titles Ordinance will be launched in due course.

IRIS Enhancements

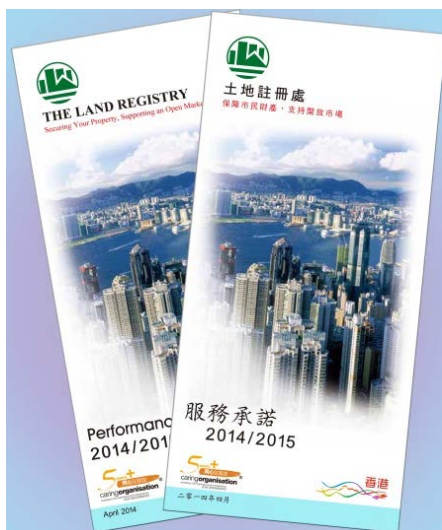

Sale of Street Index (46th edition) and New Territories Lot/Address Cross Reference Table (15th edition)

The 46th edition of the Street Index and the 15th edition of the New Territories Lot/Address Cross Reference Table (CRT) are available for sale. The order forms can be downloaded [here](#).

The new edition of the Street Index features over 560 amendments with one new street and 63 new lots/sections/subsections added. In the new CRT, over 3,200 amendments have been made and 12 new streets and 2,082 new lots/sections/subsections have been added.

The cost of the new editions of the Street Index compact disc and CRT compact disc is HK\$250 each. The respective licence fees are HK\$2,000 for a computer network linked to less than 50 terminals and HK\$4,000 if linked to 50 terminals or more.

The Land Registry launched a mobile version of the IRIS Online Services on 10 May 2014 to facilitate customers using smartphones and tablets to search land records. Liberal Studies Teaching Kit Online Version

Following the distribution in February 2013 of printed copies of a bilingual teaching kit on land registration in Hong Kong entitled "Decoding Land Registration" to all secondary schools which offer the Liberal Studies classes, the Land Registry launched an online version of the teaching kit in English, Traditional Chinese and Simplified Chinese on the Land Registry's [website](#) in November 2013. A hyperlink to the teaching kit is also available on the [website](#) of the Liberal Studies Web-based Resource Platform of HKedCity under "Reference L&T Material".

The teaching kit features the history of land registration in Hong Kong, the role and functions of the Land Registry and the reform of the land registration system in Hong Kong. It provides students with a one-stop and interactive information platform for conducting independent study. It also assists teachers to conduct research on information for preparing classroom discussions and activities on the subject.

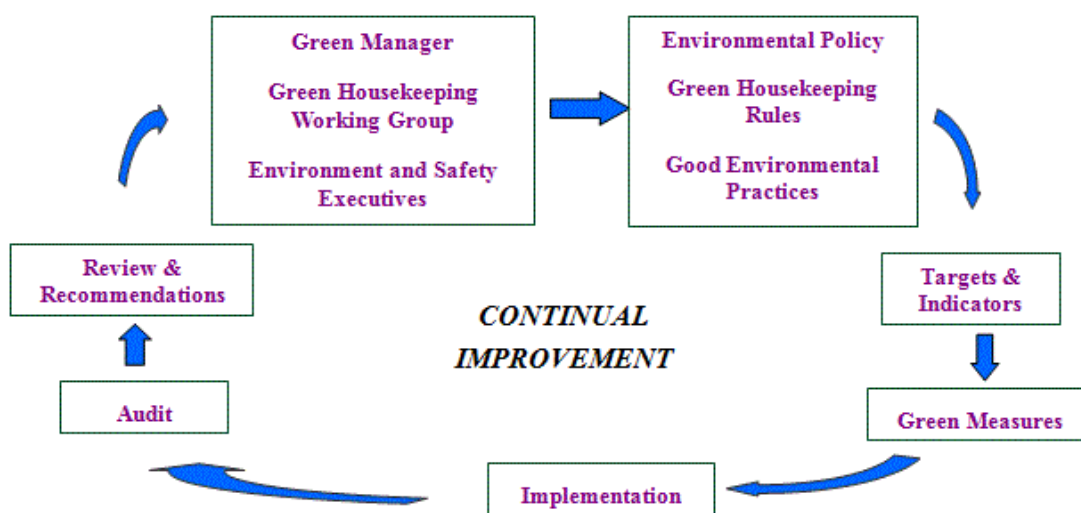

The Land Registry Environmental Management System



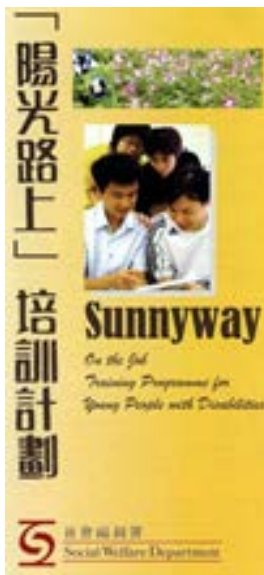
Standard Chartered Hong Kong Marathon 2014
